



COVID-19 Safety Processes

- Attendee's temperature checks will take place upon entering the check-in area prior to entry into the tournament area. Temperatures will be taken with touch-free infrared forehead thermometers to limit physical contact between staff and attendees. **'Attendees' refers to all persons including competitors, coaches, and spectators.**
- Face masks required by all attendees and staff while inside the venue except while competing or on-deck for an upcoming match.
- No payments will be taken in- person for tickets and/or registrations. **All spectator tickets and competitor registrations MUST be purchased online prior to the event start date** to eliminate physical contact between staff and attendees.
- Seating arrangements will be staggered or clearly marked to help abide with social distancing recommendations and requirements.
- Only the athletes competing in the active match and the referee officiating the match are to be on the mats at any time.
- One chair for each coach of active competitors on the mat will be provided on each side of the score tables. The chairs will be spaced out at least 3ft from edges of table to satisfy social distancing recommendations and requirements between coaches and table staff.
- Visibly marked borders and/or barriers will provide an off-limits buffer zone to separate active competitors, coaches and staff from spectators and spectators from the mat area.

Safety Provisions

- Hand Sanitizer will be readily available at ALL tables in the venue including but not limited to: check-in/weigh-in tables, scorekeeping tables and merchandise tables.
- Disposable face masks will be on-hand and available on an as-needed basis at ALL tables in the venue including but not limited to: check-in/weigh-in tables, scorekeeping tables and merchandise tables.
- Disposable gloves will be on-hand and available on an as-needed basis at ALL tables in the venue including but not limited to: check-in/weigh-in tables, scorekeeping tables and merchandise tables.
- A designated COVID-19 safety person will be on-sight to respond to any situations regarding safety concerns that may arise at all events until further notice.
